Through the generosity of the Friends of the Elwood Public Library, we are able to provide free entrance to several museums.

Beginning July 1st Elwood Public Library will have 2 different types of passes:

1. **Print on Demand:** Passes with an asterisk can be printed from home or printed at the library. **The pass will only be valid for the date of the visit** on the confirmation page, so request your pass for the day you wish to use it. No Return is Necessary!

2. **Pick Up / Return Pass:** Passes without an asterisk are **available for 3 days** and must be returned to the Information Desk and not in the Drop Box. There is a \$10 per day late fee. Replacement costs depend on each museum but start at \$10.

Passes may be reserved online or at the library up to 3 months in advance. Museum passes are for Elwood Public Library patrons with a card in good standing. Only two passes allowed per family within a 30 day period.
