Goal #1: Discover

Objective: Promote reading and literacy as a core value of the Library.

Action: Create opportunities to discover new authors and books through book displays, programs, emails, and social media posts.

Action: Promote the library as a resource for non-library sponsored community book discussion groups.

Action: Provide training to librarians to help them provide excellent reader's advisory services.

Objective: Create a warm and welcoming place for the community to gather and discover.

Action: Provide rotating themed decorations, book displays, and educational displays.

Action: Create ongoing interactive activities for children, teens, and adults to engage in any time they visit the Library.

Action: Update paint and furnishings.

Objective: Provide educational, cultural, and informational programming for children and teens that inspires them to explore and engage with the world around them.

Action: Create and experiment with new and innovative children's and teen programming and services.

Action: Provide ongoing clubs or groups based on community interest.

Objective: The Library will offer opportunities for family engagement.

Action: Implement more programs and activities for families on evenings and weekends.

Action: Promote the Library as a destination for families by offering large library-wide activities for all ages.

Objective: The Library will offer opportunities for adults to enhance and improve their lives.

Action: Use market research techniques such as online and in person surveys to determine the type of programs and services that will best serve all segments of the Elwood community.

Action: Create and offer programs that foster health and safety.

Action: Create introductory classes that inspire adults to try new hobbies, activities, and interests.

Objective: Embrace cultural diversity through programming, collection development, and resources.

Action: Create programs for all ages that help patrons understand and appreciate holidays and customs of cultures other then their own.

Action: Highlight diverse cultures using the library display case.

Action: Increase foreign language offerings.

Goal #2: Connect

Objective: Engage with our community to promote and provide library services outside the library.

Action: Research providing digital literacy services to 55 plus communities.

Action: Provide children's literacy activities and story times to daycare centers and camp groups.

Action: Facilitate book discussions at nursing homes, 55 plus communities, and other organizations.

Action: Provide the opportunity to participate in bus trips.

Objective: Comprehensively inform the public about library programs and services using social media, email, and printed materials.

Action: Create a social media and brand style guide.

Action: Create a team that meets regularly to promote and advise the community about programs and services.

Objective: Library staff connect with local community groups, businesses, and other partners to benefit the Elwood community.

Action: Promote community groups via the Elwood Bulletin Board on Facebook.

Action: Enhance current programming using the expertise of our partners.

Action: Promote the availability of meeting space for community groups.

Action: Involve local businesses in Library initiatives and events such as Halloween.

Objective: Library staff will continue to foster an excellent relationship with the Elwood School District.

Action: Reinstitute yearly meetings with school librarians.

Action: Collaborate with school district teachers, librarians, and administrators on projects to enhance student learning.

Action: Library staff will attend school district events to provide outreach to parents and students.

Objective: Maintain and enhance cooperative initiatives with the Friends of the Library.

Action: Meet with Friends of the Library board annually to plan events and discuss goals.

Objective: The Library provides technology training and resources that keep our members and staff connected with modern resources and applications.

Action: Provide one-on-one technology training to community members.

Action: Provide staff training in new and existing technologies.

Action: Create a "Preserve Your Memories" project to assist patrons with digital preservation.

Goal #3: Imagine

Objective: Become a leader in sustainability education using the triple bottom line of becoming environmentally responsible, economically feasible, and socially equitable.

Action: Complete the Sustainable Library Certification Program.

Action: Provide library services as cost effectively as possible by exploring opportunities for a permanent home that meets the needs of our expanding and changing community.

Action: Make equity, diversity, and inclusion an integrated part of organizational culture and approach to all services.
